Cake mixes and icing mixes may be used. **No female assistance** is allowed. Creation must be edible. They will serve as the snack for the evening. The use of non-edible decorations is permitted. Cakes should be placed on a tray or cardboard foundation. All cakes should have a title or theme shown on a card submitted with the cake. Each cake should be limited to one (1) box mix.
