

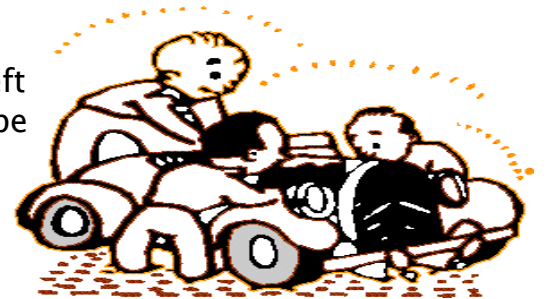

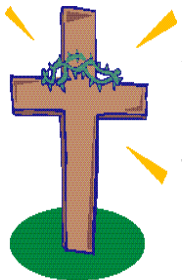
## Pinewood Derby Car Building Clinic

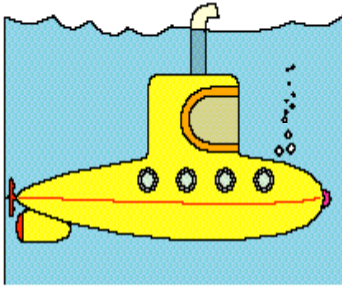
### St. Vincent De Paul Society Donation

**Blue and Gold Banquet Under The Sea Sunday, February 26, 2006 4:00 p.m.**



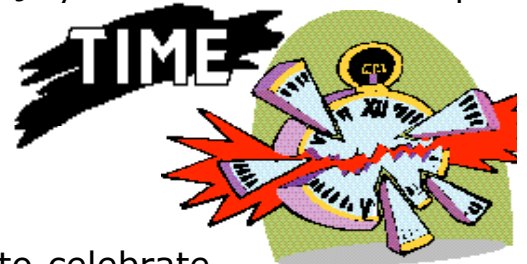

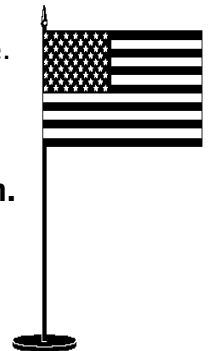
Pack Night Opening and Closing Flag ceremonies are done using the same schedule.
