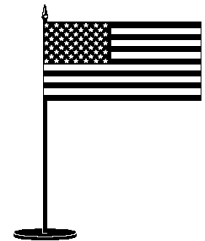
### Pack Night Setup/Cleanup and Opening/Closing Schedule
