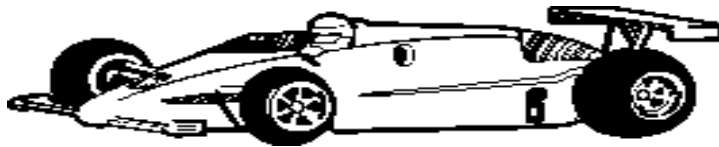
Thanks to everyone who helped with our 2007 Blue and Gold Banquet. A great deal of time and work go into making this day and our entire Scouting year a success. Thanks!

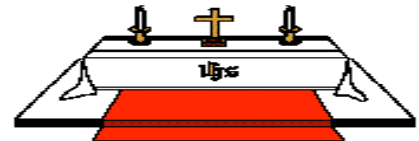

family is asked to bring 2 dozen cookies.



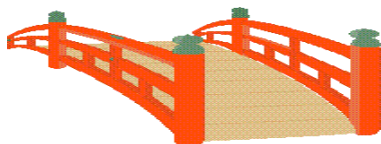
Potawatomi Trail Hike Saturday, March 31, 2007 Indiana

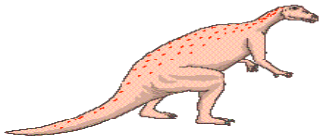
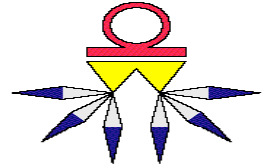
