

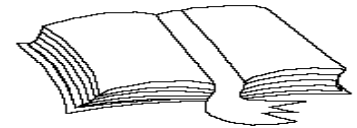

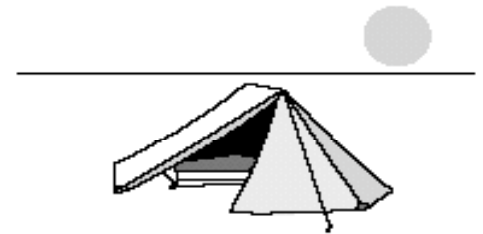
Religious Awards Booklets are available from Juanita Trivunovic. Banners and completed books are due by the November Pack Night.

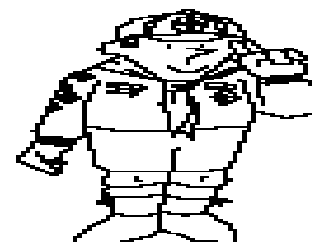
